






Demographics




The vast majority of clients (84%) are male.




The vast majority of clients (86%) are adults aged 26-59. Five percent (5%) are Transition Aged Youth, and 9% are older adults aged 60+.

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


African Americans comprised the largest number/percentage of those served (41%). Twenty-three percent (23%) identify as Caucasian, and 13% identify as Latino/Hispanic. Twenty three percent (23%) identify as Other than the above categories.




More than half (57%) of clients have a psychiatric diagnosis of schizophrenia or other thought disorder. The remainder of clients (43%) have a diagnosis of Bi-Polar/Other Mood Disorders.

Outcomes



The levels of return to custody have dropped significantly, currently being reduced by 54%. A large reason why is the level of support and therapeutic interventions clients receive.



Days spent hospitalized have dropped by 70%. Our staff is available to monitor “red flags” that indicate worsening psychiatric symptoms and intervene as necessary 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
